Tiree Parish Church

- The Church will be a 2m social distancing zone.
- Face masks will be required. Masks will be provided for those who don't have one.
- The main door will be used for both entry and exit and you must enter the sanctuary immediately. The number of people in the small corridor between the two internal doors should be kept to a minimum.
- A member of the Welcoming Team will be stationed at the entrance to record attendance and details for contact tracing. These records will be held securely for 21 days and then destroyed.
- There are areas of the church which will be out of bounds and this will be clearly indicated by read and white tape and 'No Entry' signs.

 This will include the toilet which will be unavailable.
- Jackets/coats/jumpers etc. must remain with you.
- Signage will be in place to inform everyone what to do and where to go. Please obey all the signs.
- A Stewards will be there to guide you to a seat. Those seats available during worship will be clearly indicated.
- There will be hand sanitiser at the point of entry/exit.
- Offerings can be placed on open plates on arrival.
- **✗** DO NOT ATTEND if you show symptoms of COVID-19.
- if you do wish to attend, then we welcome you back to Tiree Parish Church and we hope you enjoy the services. If you feel safer at home, these services will be recorded and made available thereafter.
